NO EXHIBITS ACCEPTED AFTER 10am MONDAY 1st NOVEMBER 2021

Any article that has won a prize at a previous Upper Blackwood Show must not be entered.

Linen *may be washed*, Garments *may be shown* if wash and wear marks are not obvious. It is preferable *not to wash* yarn work.

If more than three items of the same medium of work are entered in “Any other article not otherwise specified” they may be judged *separately*.

In the case of equal quality work, handwork has preference over machine work.

All Entries will be exhibited behind protective screens.

PRESENTATION: EXHIBIT CARDS TO BE SAFETY PINNED, SEWN OR TAPED TO ARTICLES ENTERED. This method also to be used for mounting any work e.g. lacework onto cardboard.

All Exhibits must have names covered.

Make sure *all ends* in Patchwork and Knitting are finished off.

Cushion corners need to be filled.



Be aware of colour combinations in knee rugs; avoid bulky joins.
